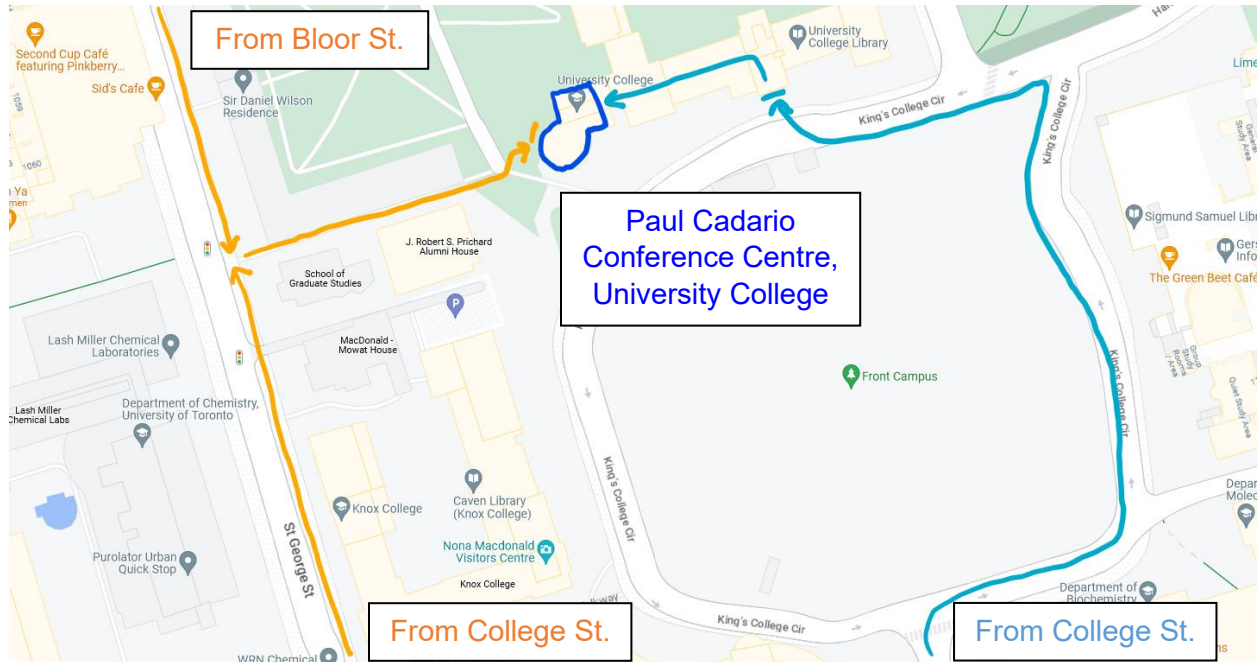


Getting to the Paul Cadario Conference Centre, University College, University of Toronto. Please be aware that there is construction going on at the UoFT front campus, which makes some of the roads inaccessible. There are two ways of getting to the conference centre: the “orange” and the “blue” routes on the map here, that are described in more detail below.



From St George St (the “orange” route):

Walk south on St George St from Bloor St or north on St George St from College St. Take a turn into the alley between the Sir Daniel Wilson Residence and the School of Graduate Studies. This is the view on the alley from St George St:



Walk straight ahead to the Paul Cadario Conference Centre and use the door on the left (photo on the left), marked with an ouroboros (photo on the right):



From College St (the “blue” route):

Walk towards the UofT front campus through the main campus gate from College St. You’ll see the University College building that houses the conference centre in the distance:



Follow the path to the big front door of University College and enter here. Take a left inside and follow the signs to the Paul Cadario Conference Centre. This is what the front door looks like:



Enter here.
