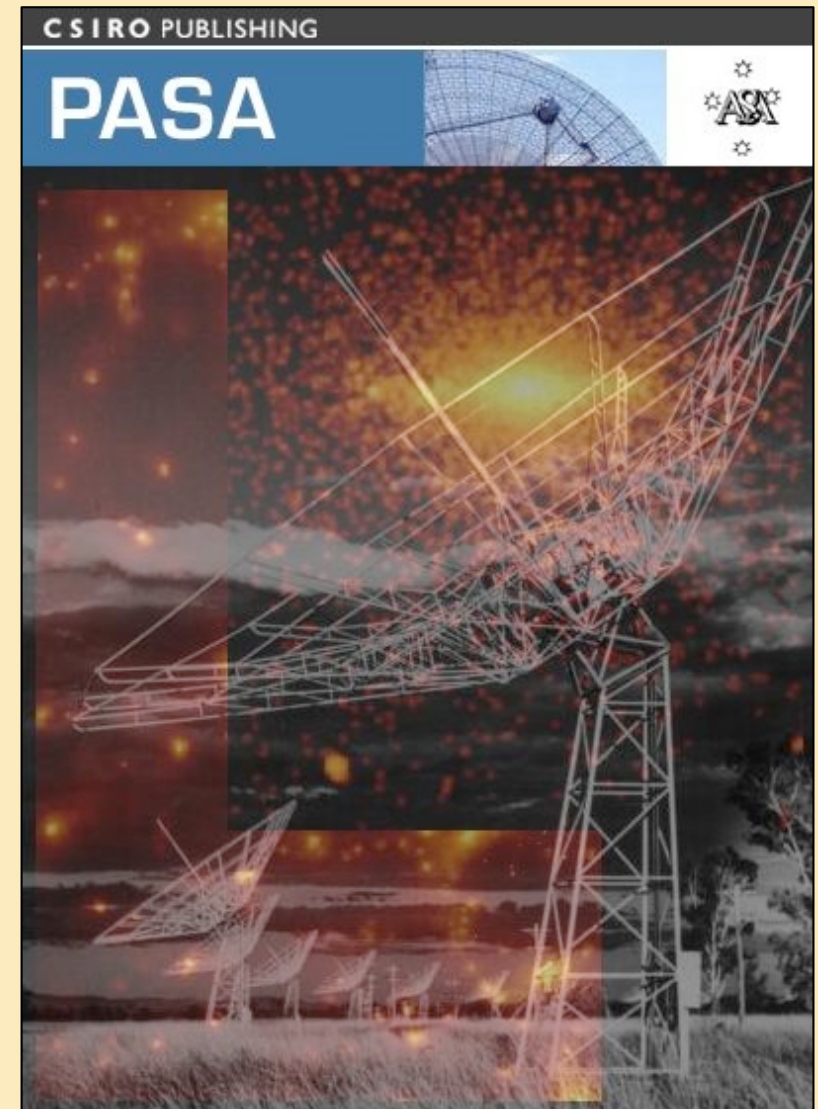

 - **2009 ISI impact factor 2.56**



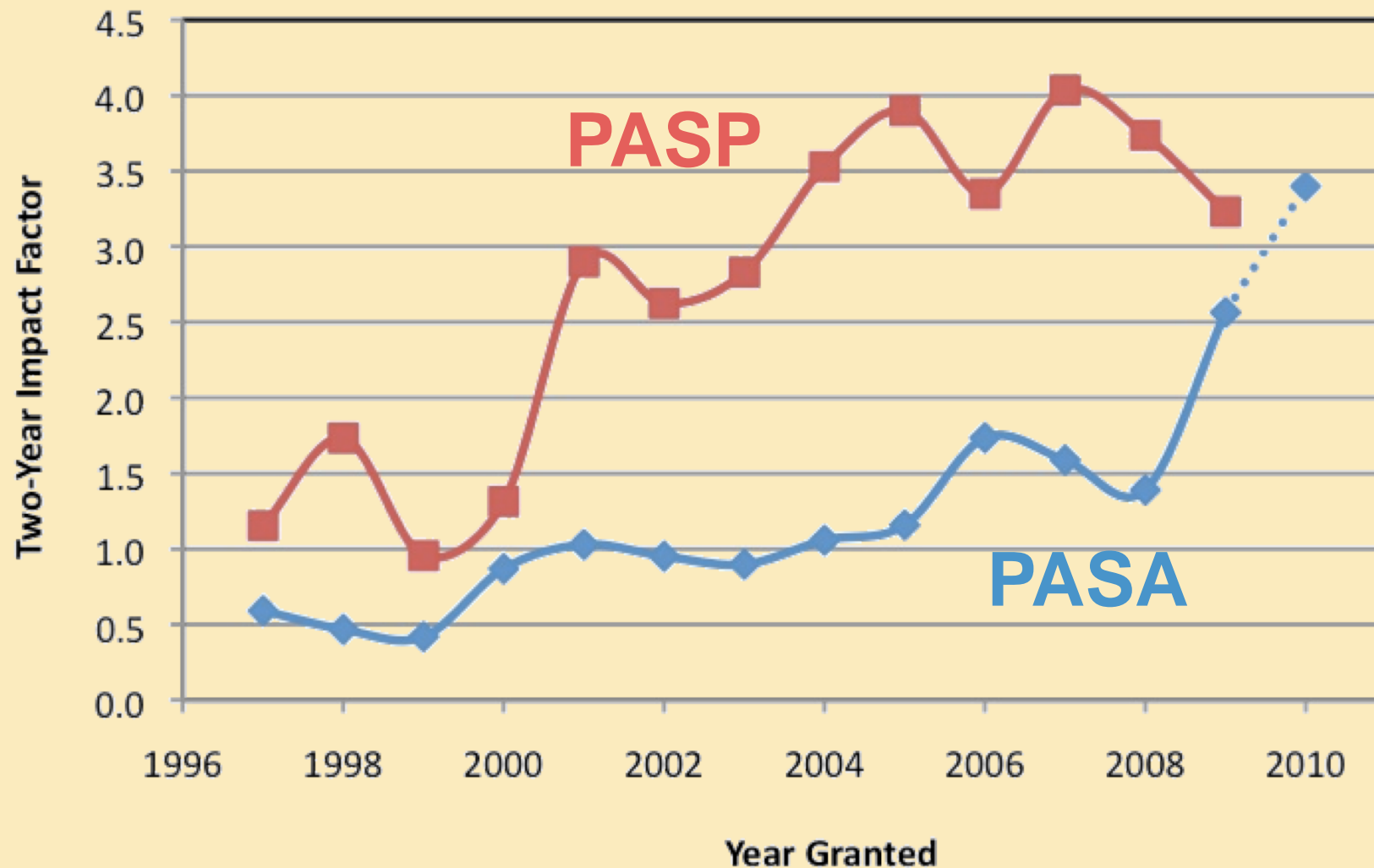

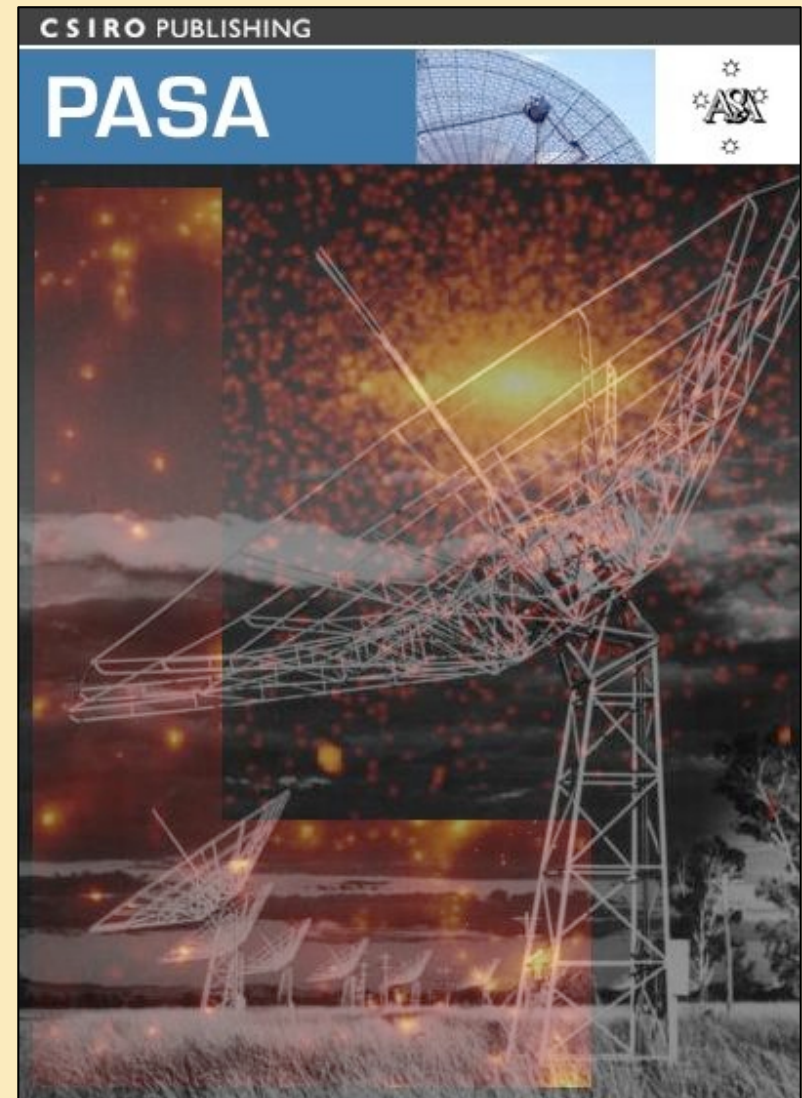
PASA Impact Factor

Impact Factor vs. Time

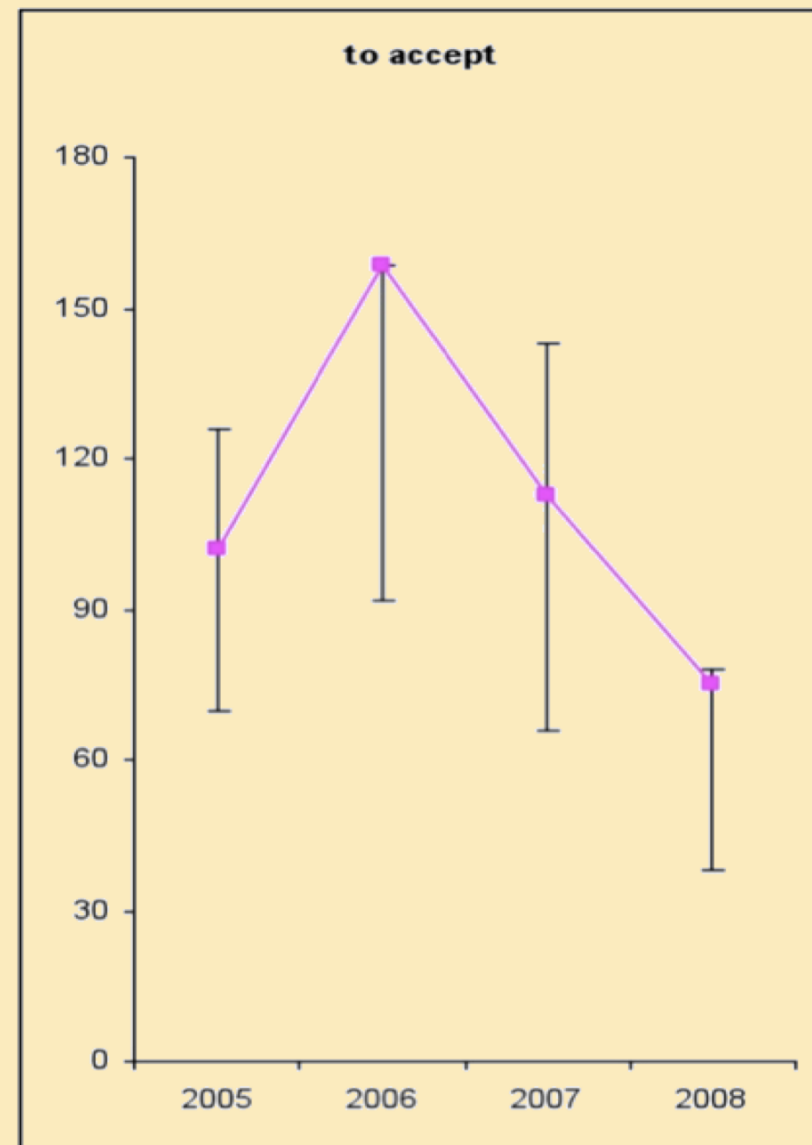
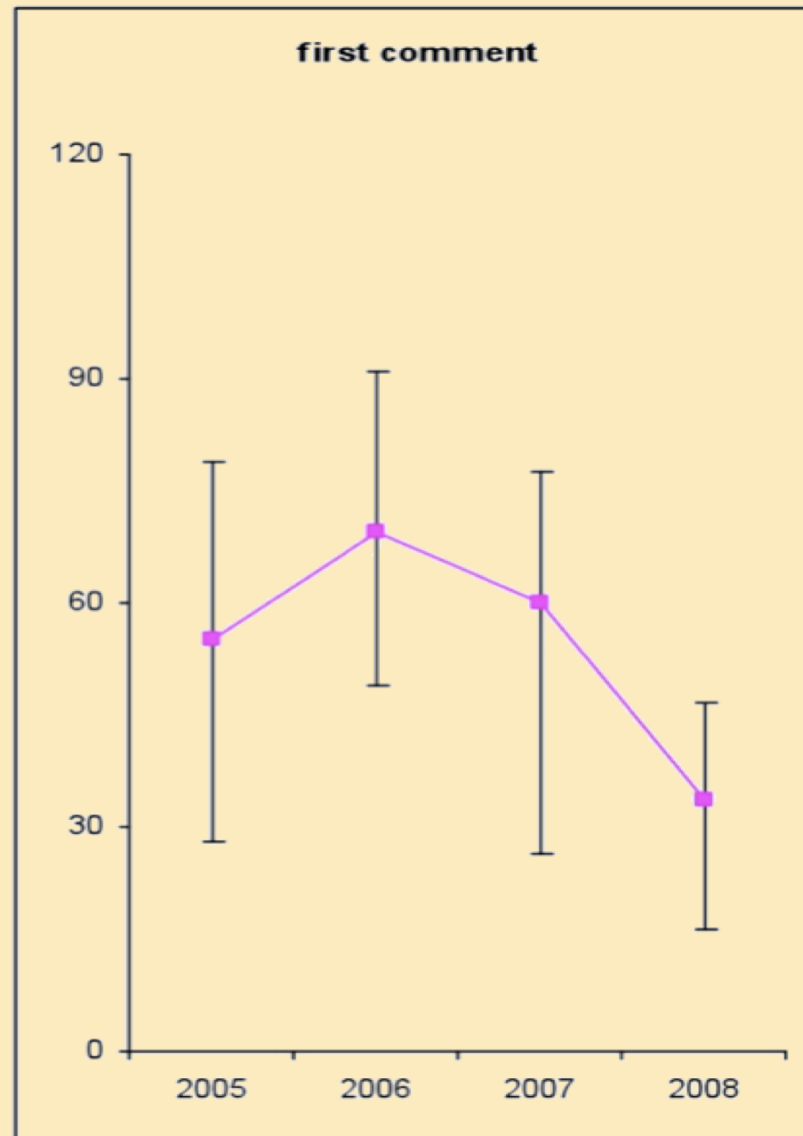


Forthcoming Highlights
